Day 7 Split - Ston - Dubrovnik

On our way to Dubrovnik, we will stop near the town of Ston to visit a local winery and taste the famous "Plavac Mali" wine, a very close relative to the Zinfandel. In this winery the traditional wine-making business has been passed on for generations, offering a unique story everyone wants to hear. The wine tasting includes a wine presentation on all the specifics of the wine-making process, wine tasting, and a snack. Arrival in Dubrovnik, dinner and overnight. (Driving time 5 hours) (B,T, D)

Day 6 Thursday, Hvar - Bol - Pucisca

We'll start our day with a morning departure towards Bol. Bol is famous for having one of the finest European beaches, called Zlatni Rat (Golden Cape).

As we stop in Bol, you can relax in this charming Dalmatian town. Have a walk, a cup of coffee or a swim, until lunch is served on board. This evening we will have Captain's dinner on board. Overnight in Pučišća, (B,L, Captain's dinner).

Day 7, Friday, Pucisca - Omis - Split

After breakfast we'll cruise across the Brač channel to Omiš, an ancient town with city walls, fortresses and stone churches. Omiš is located at the delta of Cetina River, with its wonderful beaches. 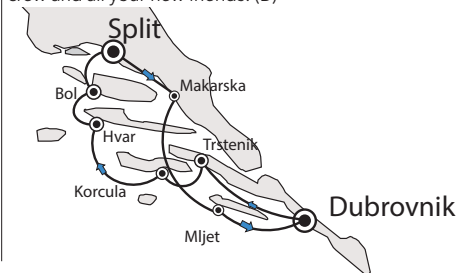

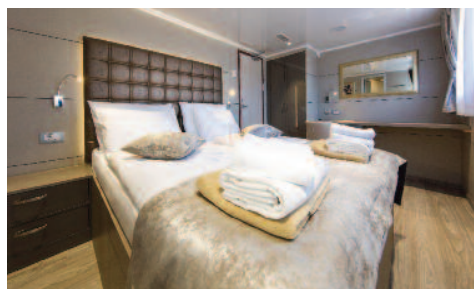

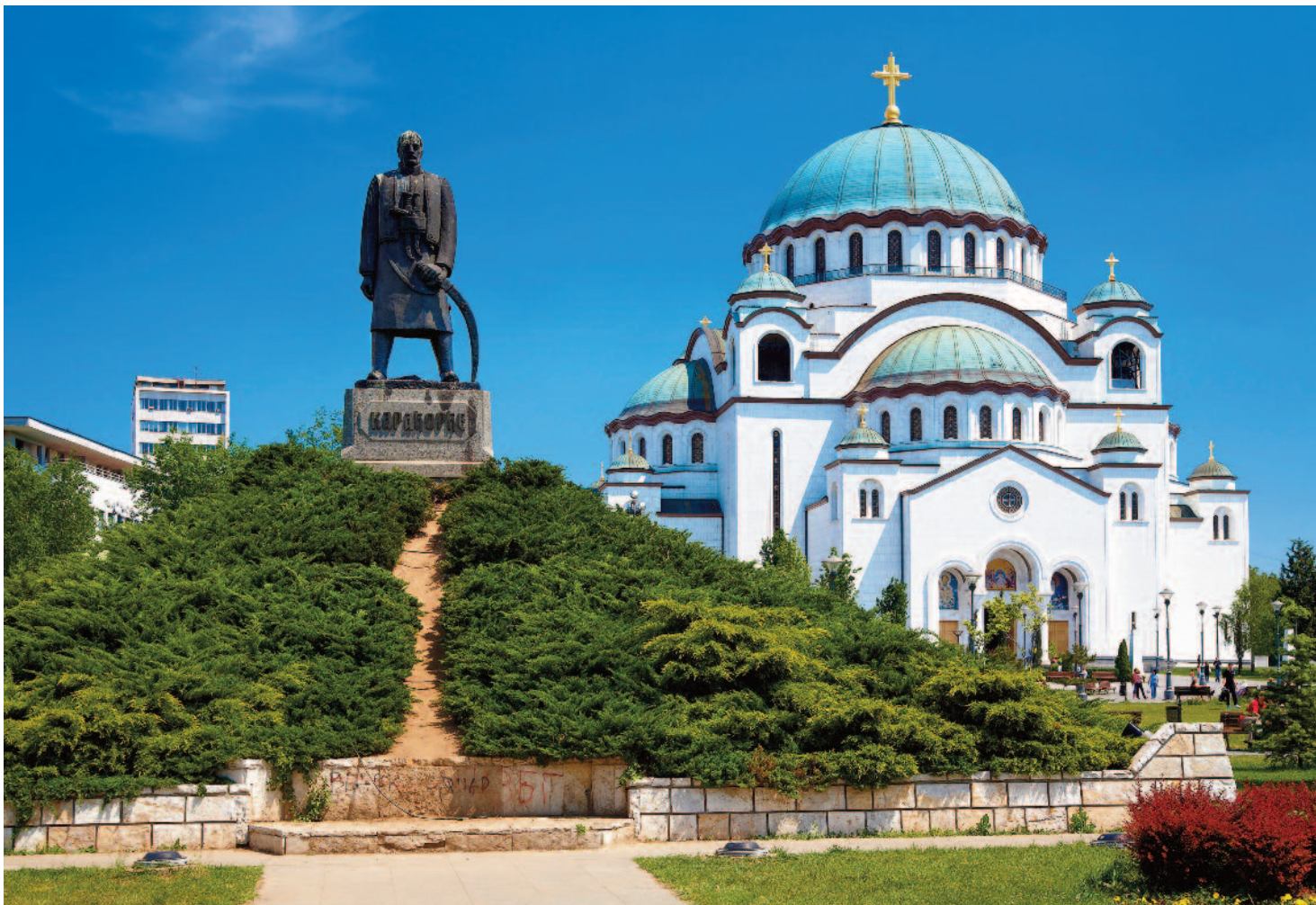

Stroll along the historic streets of Dunavska and Zmaj Jovina in the pedestrian zone and see the elegant City Hall and get some free time for lunch (not included) in a traditional restaurant of Voivodina.



Danube Tour

Operation: Wed, Fri, Sat (Apr - Oct)

Duration : 8 hours

Drive to Viminacium - a Roman town and military fortification from the 2nd century that once was the capital of Roman Province of Moesia Superior. For centuries it had been a crossroad. At this archaeological park you'll see perfectly saved late antique frescos of the Roman Empire, a mausoleum, spa, a Roman amphitheater etc. Then continue to the Golubac Fortress. It was built on inaccessible cliffs near the widest part of the Danube (around 6km) and nowadays is one of the best-preserved fortresses in Serbia. The next and last stop is Lepenski Vir - one of the biggest and most important archaeological sites on this territory. See prehistoric urban settlements that have been populated 8000 years ago, cultural, architectural heritage of Lepenski Vir culture and their way of life. In the evening, return to Belgrade.

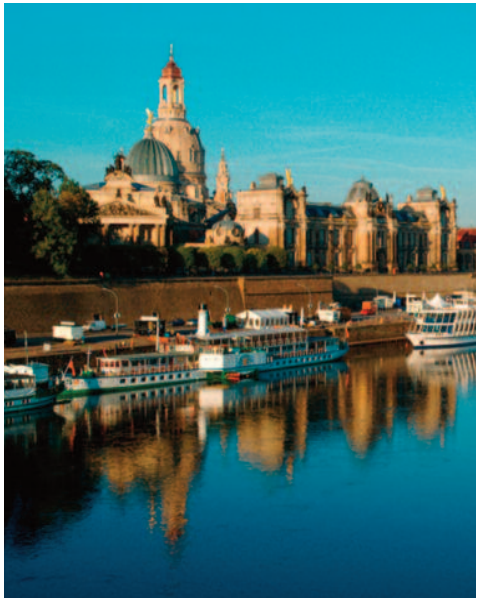

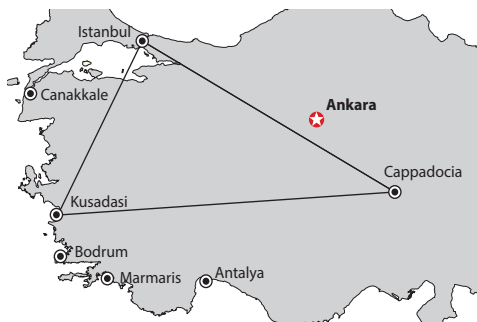

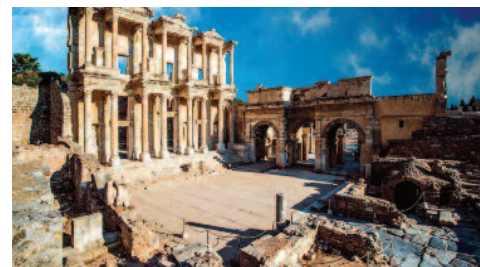

FINAL PAYMENT:
